EDUCATION

The education status of our operational area is very poor and below the national status. The overall literacy rates is only 43% and the female literacy rate is just 22%, even few children do not complete their standard 4 education.

Around 50% of those who complete standard four and enroll for upper primary education and there are only few who reaches for higher secondary education. Early childhood education or pre primary education of ease people are very essential. Though we have felt need of promotion of illiteracy to eliminate miserie of the poor as well as to sustain the achieved development by self reliance and confidant

There is a permanent training cum production in our own mat and it is still running. the productions are sold in our own country and also in the foreign market. It is producted by both rural backward S.H.G. women and man. Apart from it, we have trained S.H.G. Women on Mat, Baboy gras, Fish Scale & Tailoring (Dress) in many places (own block & block) financial help granted by I.C. D.S. cell Paschim Medinipur & also helped by NABARD.

BASIS OF ORGANISATION

Some energetic youth have found that since long days the interior rural area where the poor community resides are neglected by the Government personnel, efforts for welfare work in respect of infrastructure. Income generation, education, health, are most nil. The authority even doesn't feel to visit these areas.

In the circumstances under the leadership of Haripada Jana these youths set a new journey to agitate and snatch the required services, taking participation if the rural masses to ensure the services as required or fell needs by the people.

These movements started with a small venue, gradually it takes as an momentum in this remote village of recently declared paschim medinipur, later it evolved into an organization known as Barchara Progressive Cultural Forum it is a registered under the societies registration Act 2006 – 2007 an received recognition from Government of India to access foreign aids onwards. The organization has its own office in the village of Barchara about 2 hours (2 minutes) drives from Balichak Station.

SOCIO ECONOMIC STATUS

The area is rural and having 75% of its population depending on agriculture allied sectors. 68% of it is cultivated land and the rest is home step consisting of small ponds kitchen garden.

Out of total population in the block about 28% belongs to the scheduled castes 30% Muslims 18% OBC and 24% general category Hindus. Only 50% of the families have agriculture where 30% are small farmers whose land holding is less than 2.5 big has area per family own more than 5 big has of land.

Nearly 37% of the population live below poverty line. The land less agricultural laborer who constitute 50% of the population get only 180 to 200 days of work during the year.

ANIMATION & AWARENESS BUILDING.

BPCF, believes without awareness and animation any society or community people can not be developed. With a view to ensure our mission and people's active participation at all stage of work we have organized many action oriented awareness camps on various physical, environmental, Social & Socio economic issues.
